Dear Friends,

Mid Central Community Action, Inc. continues its work to achieve healthy relationships, finances, homes, and neighborhoods through our Next Step™ Financial Opportunity Center®, our Countering Domestic Violence Services (24-Hour Hotline 309-827-7070), and Mayors Manor.

This past year we brought in a Housing Stability Navigator, who partnered with community members, faith-based organizations, and other nonprofits to transition precariously housed families into safe, affordable housing. We replaced the roof on our corporate office to ensure the health and safety of our on-site staff. Additionally, we've updated many areas of Neville House (our domestic violence shelter) to make it feel more like a home for survivors. We continue to strive to make Mayors Manor sustainable and secured donations to beautify the grounds, making it a welcoming place for residents, and for their guests.

Our focus in the upcoming year will be to expand our Next Step™ Program to local businesses, to offer it as a part of their employee benefit packages. Studies show when employees have financial burdens, the resulting stress lowers productivity. By partnering with employers, we can help the employees reduce the negative impact of those financial burdens - educating, equipping, and empowering them to achieve financial stability.

Thank you to all who donated, volunteered, or supported MCCA this year. A special Thank You to our dedicated Board of Directors and Staff, who work diligently to assist our clients, residents, customers, survivors, and community members. We truly cannot do this work without every one of you!




